



Lucinda Laird, Paris Disciplinary Board, Clergy

The Very Rev. Lucinda Laird is the Dean and Rector of the Cathedral Church of the Holy Trinity, commonly known as the American Cathedral in Paris. She has been Dean since March 2013.

Previously, Dean Laird served for 15 years as Rector of St. Matthew's Episcopal Church in Louisville, KY, and for 11 years as Rector of St. Mark's Church in Teaneck, NJ. She has been active in the Episcopal Church at both the diocesan and national levels:

- General Convention Deputy (3 times from Newark, 2 times from KY)
- Standing Committee (both dioceses)
- Commission on Ministry (both dioceses)
- Diocesan Council/Trustees & Council (both dioceses)
- Ecclesiastical Court (KY)
- Ecumenical Officer (Newark)

She has also served on the Board of Trustees of: The General Theological Seminary; Berea College; and, in Louisville, Faith Channel 19 and Wellspring Mental Health Recovery.

Dean Laird holds a B.A. from Barnard College, Columbia University, and an M.Div. from The General Theological Seminary.
